## **CONFESSION OF SINS**

Worship Leader: On one of his missionary journeys, Paul said, “I preached that they should repent and turn to God and demonstrate their repentance by their deeds.” Confessing our sins is more than just going through the motions and saying, “I am so sorry”—just to turn around and keep doing the same thing. Jesus said to the Pharisees, “Produce fruit in keeping with repentance . . . . The axe is already at the root of the trees, and every tree that does not produce good fruit will be cut down and thrown into the fire.” Jesus is the Vine and we are the branches. Confessing our sins and changing our behavior helps our relationship with God. Apart from him, we are not able to produce fruit. So let us confess our sins:

**Congregation: Heavenly Father, I struggle with the same sins. I think about things I should not think, I say things I should not say and I do things I should not do. There are times I do not even recognize that I have sinned. On my own I cannot earn your forgiveness and I know I do not deserve it. But please have mercy on me, assure me that I am forgiven, and strengthen me to live my life for you and because of what Jesus has done.**

WL: Our heavenly Father is loving, patient, and kind. He sees you are blameless and holy because of the perfect life and innocent death of our Lord Jesus Christ. Every sin you have ever committed has been wiped away. Go in peace with the full assurance that your sins are forgiven. Go with the confidence found in the empty tomb. Amen.

## **APOSTLES’ CREED**

**I believe in God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth.**

**I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into hell. The third day he rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty. From there he will come to judge the living and the dead.**

<sup>1</sup> After this, Jesus went around in Galilee. He did not want to go about in Judea because the Jewish leaders there were looking for a way to kill him. <sup>2</sup> But when the Jewish Festival of Tabernacles was near, <sup>3</sup> Jesus' brothers said to him,

"Leave Galilee and go to Judea, so that your disciples there may see the works you do.

<sup>4</sup> No one who wants to become a public figure acts in secret. Since you are doing these things, show yourself to the world."

<sup>5</sup> For even his own brothers did not believe in him.

<sup>6</sup> Therefore Jesus told them, "My time is not yet here; for you any time will do. <sup>7</sup> The world cannot hate you, but it hates me because I testify that its works are evil. <sup>8</sup> You

go to the festival. I am not going up to this festival, because my time has not yet fully come." <sup>9</sup> After he had said this, he stayed in Galilee. <sup>10</sup> However, after his brothers had left for the festival, he went also, not publicly, but in secret.

<sup>11</sup> Now at the festival the Jewish leaders were watching for Jesus and asking, "Where is he?"

<sup>12</sup> Among the crowds there was widespread whispering about him. Some said, "He is a good man."

Others replied, "No, he deceives the people." <sup>13</sup> But no one would say anything publicly about him for fear of the leaders.

<sup>12</sup> Then the apostles returned to Jerusalem from the hill called the Mount of Olives, a Sabbath day's walk from the city. <sup>13</sup> When they arrived, they went upstairs to the room where they were staying.

Those present were Peter, John, James and Andrew; Philip and Thomas, Bartholomew

and Matthew; James son of Alphaeus and Simon the Zealot, and Judas son of James.

<sup>14</sup> They all joined together constantly in prayer, along with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brothers.
