CONFESSION OF SINS

Worship Leader: Satan is maliciously creative as he tries to deceive us and lead us to sin. Consider the Garden of Eden. “Did God really say...” —he takes God’s own words and twists them into a different perspective, one which God did not intend. This carried on after Adam and Eve fell into sin; they started passing the blame to God. “The serpent deceived me, and I ate!” Satan twisted and warped the truth; and by doing so, also their minds. “The woman YOU put here with me gave it to me and I ate!” Adam and Eve became bitter and began seeing God as the enemy and putting distance between each other—likely they both felt alone. Satan still twists the truth, twists our perception and when we feel alone, he misleads us away from God and directs us to sin.

So now we come before our merciful, heavenly Father and confess where we have strayed, where we have done wrong—our sins. Yet not to further the feeling of separation, but to be reconciled to him, through him, by his Son. We are not alone in our sin, he tells us, “I am. I am for you, in you, among you” (*Exodus 3:14ff*). Let us confess:

Congregation: Heavenly Father, I have sinned against you in more ways than I can count. I have sinned in my thoughts, by my words and with my actions. There are sins I know I have done and sins that I do not know I have done. Have mercy on me according to your unfailing love. Call me from the darkness into your wonderful light. Assure me of your love for me, cleanse me from my sin, and take away my guilt.

ANNOUNCEMENT OF GOD’S FORGIVENESS

WL: God, our Heavenly Father, is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger and rich in faithful love. By the perfect life and innocent death of our Lord Jesus Christ, he has removed your guilt forever. You are righteous in God’s sight and named as an heir of heaven. May the God of hope fill you with the peace and joy that comes only through his forgiveness. Amen.

APOSTLES' CREED

I believe in God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth.

I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried.
