## **CONFESSION OF SINS**

Worship Leader: On his missionary journey Paul says, “I preached that they should repent and turn to God and demonstrate their repentance by their deeds” (Acts 26:20). Confessing our sins is more than just going through the motions and saying, “I am so sorry”—just to turn around and keep doing the same thing. Just as Jesus said to the Pharisees, “Produce fruit in keeping with repentance.... The axe is already at the root of the trees, and every tree that does not produce good fruit will be cut down and thrown into the fire” (Matthew 3:10). Jesus is the Vine and we are the branches. Confessing our sins, receiving God’s forgiveness, and striving to change our behavior nurtures our relationship with God. Apart from him, we are not able to produce fruit. So, let us confess our sins:

**Congregation: Have mercy on me, O God. According to your unfailing love, according to your great compassion blot out my transgressions and cleanse me from my sin. For I know my sins, sin of thought, word, and deed; they are always before me. Against you—and you alone—have I sinned. My heart is broken and contrite over what I have done and failed to do. Forgive me for Jesus sake. Create in me a clean heart and renew a right spirit within me. Do not cast me from your presence or take your Holy Spirit from me. Restore in me the joy of your salvation and grant a willing spirit to sustain me.**

## **ANNOUNCEMENT OF GOD’S FORGIVENESS**

WL: This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins. And this is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. He died to remove your guilt and sin forever. He died and does not remember your sins. He died so that you never will. Go in peace; your sins are forgiven. Amen.

**GUIDANCE FOR THE JOURNEY:**  
***THE DESIRES OF OUR HEARTS***

*A recent survey indicated “high anxiety among Americans during COVID-19 pandemic.” In addition to anxiety caused by COVID-19, all of us may have other anxiety-causing matters before us in our personal lives. And so, considering what’s going on related to COVID-19 and other matters, some have commented, “It’s a crazy time.”*

*How does one make it through such a time as this?  
How do Christians travel this part of the journey of their lives?*

*The Bible tells us about a large group of God’s people on a journey. They were the Nation of Israel after God rescued them from slavery in Egypt. They had present and future challenges before them. However, they were blessed with relationship with God and with one another. To use the current slogan, they were “in it together.”*

*But how did they make their way? How did they do the journey?*

*The Bible tells us that God guided them. One of the ways through which God guided Israel was through what we call the Ten Commandments. God used the Ten Commandments to direct Israel in their relationship with him and with one another.*
