## CONFESSION OF SINS

Worship Leader: 1 Corinthians 1:25 says, “The foolishness of God is wiser than human wisdom, and the weakness of God is stronger than human strength.” But how often do we find our weakness is our own wisdom? We often go to great lengths to have things make sense, and sometimes in our search for true understanding we look back and see that we have gone down a path that did not show ourselves trusting in God—but shows that we misplaced our faith.

Perhaps we have relied too much on human wisdom. For what is faith from the perspective of human wisdom? What society often calls “faith” may better be called “speculation.” Faith is said to be *“an idea that I have come up with—in which I can hope. It really doesn’t matter what the idea is; it just matters that I hope in it.”*

This is a tragedy, because the object of faith is the only thing that makes it valuable. The hunger for “hopeful speculation” is driven by the need to feel “okay” with ourselves and to feel we are not alone. Thus, in our human wisdom, we create excuses for ourselves, for our mistakes, and for the ever-present problem of suffering that accompanies our lives. We are trying to do is justify ourselves. Yet at the same time there is always a part of us wondering if we have ever done enough.

It is through something that sounds foolish to human ears that we have been saved—through the innocent death and resurrection of Jesus. By this, Christ has become for us wisdom from God—our righteousness and redemption. And so, on account of our sinfulness, and on account of the salvation from sin that Jesus offers, let us confess our sins to God and receive his forgiveness:

**Congregation: Heavenly Father, I have sinned against you in more ways than I can count. I have sinned in my thoughts, by my words and with my actions. There are times I have not forgiven as you have forgiven me. Forgive me for my sins, show mercy according to your unfailing love, and take away my guilt. Renew me and lead me as I strive to live for you.**

## ANNOUNCEMENT OF GOD’S FORGIVENESS

WL: God, our Heavenly Father, is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger and rich in faithful love. He has promised us, “Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you,”—and has fulfilled that promise by the perfect life and innocent death of our Lord Jesus Christ. He has forgiven every one of your sins and remembers them no more. May the God of hope fill you with the peace and joy that comes only through his forgiveness. Amen.

Be very careful, then, how you live—not as unwise but as wise, <sup>16</sup> making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil. <sup>17</sup> Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is. <sup>18</sup> Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery.

Instead, be filled with the Spirit, <sup>19</sup> speaking to one another with psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit. Sing and make music from your heart to the Lord, <sup>20</sup> always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.
