CONFESSION OF SINS

Worship Leader: There can be times when it seems nearly pointless to pray, as if God won't listen—whether because we feel 'unworthy' or because we have prayed the same prayer so many times that it seems there is no answer. But God tells us, "Before they call, I will answer; while they are still speaking, I will hear" (*Isaiah 65:64*).

In a sin-sick world, there are times we fall short in our thinking about God. We apply human qualities to God that cannot apply to him. We may feel like we may annoy him with our prayers, but God only feels unconditional love for us. "'For I know the plans I have for you,' declares the Lord, 'plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you'" (*Jeremiah 29:11-12*).

God wants us to come to him in prayer: "Is anyone among you in trouble? Let them pray. Is anyone happy? Let them sing songs of praise. Is anyone among you sick? Let them call the elders of the church to pray over them and anoint them with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise them up. If they have sinned, they will be forgiven. Therefore, confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective" (*James 5:13-16*). So, let us do just that, confess our sins and receive the healing and comfort of hearing our sins forgiven.

Congregation: Lord, you have given me my body and soul, my eyes and ears, my mind and all my abilities. You have richly and daily provided all I need to support my body and life. Yet with all these blessings I have continued to sin—in thought, word, and deed. Lord, I pray you have mercy on me, according to your unfailing love, according to your great compassion blot out my transgressions and cleanse me from my sin. Assure me of your complete forgiveness and love for me. Renew me, give me peace, and lead me to follow you.

MARK 1:29-39

As soon as they left the synagogue, they went with James and John to the home of Simon and Andrew. ³⁰ Simon's mother-in-law was in bed with a fever, and they immediately told Jesus about her.
