WL: We have begun worship with praise to God. It makes sense that we do this. Every breath we take, the food we eat, the roofs that shelter us, the clothes we wear, the people who love us, the people to whom we show love, and the faith in Jesus that gives us spiritual life—all these things and countless other—come from God. Today's First Scripture Lesson tells of the ever-present love of God through which we are continuously and endlessly blessed.

FIRST LESSON Romans 8:35-39

Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall trouble or hardship or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword?

³⁶ As it is written: "For your sake we face death all day long; we are considered as sheep to be slaughtered."

³⁷ No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. 38 For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, ³⁹ neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

CONFESSION OF SINS

Worship Leader: The Lord invites each of us to come to his table, to be fed, to be provided for, to be satisfied. He is the one from whose love we cannot be separated. Even if "that thing" that is trying or threatening to separate us is our own thoughts, words, or actions. He reminds us that we can always come to him, and he encourages us like this:

SECOND LESSON Isaiah 55:1-5

- "Come, all you who are thirsty, come to the waters; and you who have no money, come, buy and eat! Come, buy wine and milk without money and without cost.
- ² Why spend money on what is not bread, and your labor on what does not satisfy? Listen, listen to me, and eat what is good, and you will delight in the richest of fare.
- ³ Give ear and come to me; listen, that you may live. I will make an everlasting covenant with you, my faithful love promised to David.
- ⁴ See, I have made him a witness to the peoples, a ruler and commander of the peoples. ⁵ Surely you will summon nations you know not, and nations you do not know will come running to you, because of the LORD your God, the Holy One of Israel, for he has endowed you with splendor."

MESSAGE: The Feeding of the 5,000 & COVID-19

MATTHEW 14:13-21

When Jesus heard what had happened, he withdrew by boat privately to a solitary place. Hearing of this, the crowds followed him on foot from the towns.

- ¹⁴ When Jesus landed and saw a large crowd, he had compassion on them and healed their sick.
- ¹⁵ As evening approached, the disciples came to him and said, "This is a remote place, and it's already getting late. Send the crowds away, so they can go to the villages and buy themselves some food."
- ¹⁶ Jesus replied, "They do not need to go away. You give them something to eat."
 ¹⁷ "We have here only five loaves of bread and two fish," they answered.

- ¹⁸ "Bring them here to me," he said.
