CONFESSION OF SINS & ANNOUNCEMENT OF GOD'S FORGIVENESS

Through the Confession of Sins, we together confess our sins to God, expressing our need for God's forgiveness. As we hear the Announcement of God's Forgiveness, we see the mercy and love of God through the work of his Son, Jesus, and enjoy forgiveness and peace through faith in him. Today's Confession of Sins & Announcement of God's Forgiveness are based on today's Gospel Reading, Luke 19:29-40, and today's Message Lesson, Luke 19:10.

Pastor Kevin: As the crowds once cried "Hosanna!" we too come today, lifting our voices in praise. But even as we shout, we know our hearts have often wandered. We have tried to save ourselves. We have looked for peace in places other than Jesus. We have lived as if he came for someone else, not for us. So now, in the stillness, we confess our sins to the One who rode into Jerusalem not for selfish glory, but for our salvation. Let us pray.

Grace Family: Lord Jesus, you came to seek and to save the lost—but we confess, we have often hidden from you. We resist your grace and doubt your love. We cry "Hosanna" one moment and turn away the next. Forgive us for our pride, our fear, and our indifference. Remind us again that you came not to condemn us, but to rescue us. Jesus, you are *for us*. Help us to trust that truth, and to live in the freedom joy of your forgiveness. Amen.

Pastor Kevin: Hear the good news of Palm Sunday:

Jesus didn't come to watch from a distance. He came go to the cross, to carry your sin, to suffer in your place, to die your death, and to rise so you might live.

Luke 19:10 says, "The Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost."

That means Jesus came for you—in your brokenness, in your wandering, in your need.

Because of his death, your sins are forgiven.

Because of his victory, you are made new.

Because of his love, your heart is restored.

In the name of the Father, and of the † Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

I believe in God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth.

PALM SUNDAY: JESUS FOR YOU

*message based on Luke 19:10
page 878 in the pew Bibles*

Palm Sunday remembers and celebrates Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem, not as a conquering king by worldly standards, but as our humble Savior on a mission. In Luke 19:10, Jesus clearly proclaims his mission: "to seek and to save the lost." This is the heart of Palm Sunday—Jesus rode into Jerusalem not for selfish glory, but for us. He came to rescue sinners, to bring peace with God through his death on the cross, and to give life through the empty tomb to all who believe in him. Amid the palm branches and shouts of "Hosanna," we see a Savior whose eyes are fixed on his cross and empty tomb—all because he came *for you*.

PRAYER

Following the prayer:

All: Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever and ever. Amen.
